

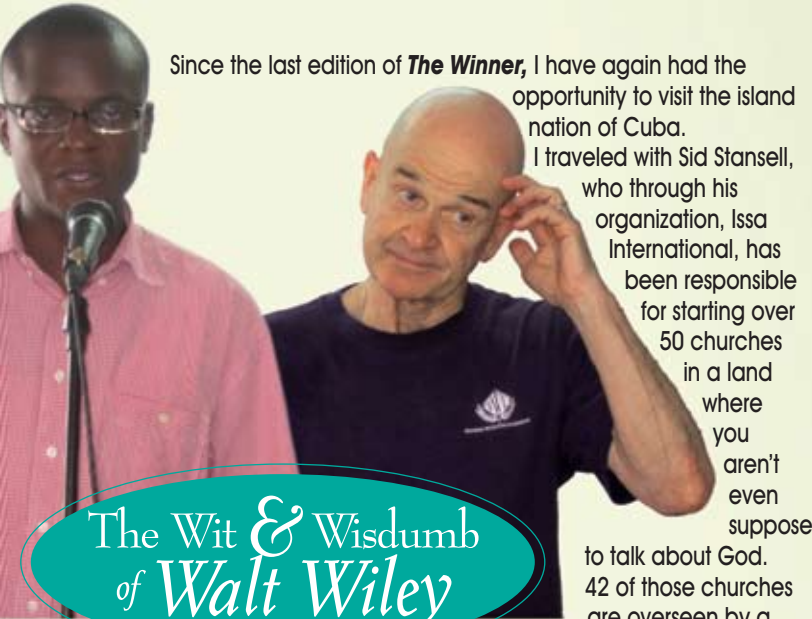

Since the last edition of *The Winner*, I have again had the opportunity to visit the island nation of Cuba.

I traveled with Sid Stansell, who through his organization, Issa International, has been responsible for starting over 50 churches in a land where you aren't even suppose

to talk about God. 42 of those churches are overseen by a 33 year-old named

Ernesto. It's really quite amazing!

Sid, along with Ernesto and a host pastor in Havana, had organized a three-day conference for the pastors of many of those churches, and I was invited to join Sid to share with them.

Allow me to reflect on what we did, what I heard, and what I observed from that experience:

1. Strangely, none of those in attendance spoke English, and since my Spanish is limited to two phrases ("Pardon me, where is the bathroom?" and "You can tie your horse over there."), we had to

work through an interpreter. His name was Dino (pictured with Walt), and he was from Suriname. Go figure!

2. They had nice printed schedules for the conference which stated we were to start at 9 a.m. I discovered that was more of a suggestion than an edict.

3. If the pastors didn't seem to care when we started, they cared even less about when we ended. As long as we would talk they were content to listen. They were like sponges.

4. They don't have anything. Really, they don't! Go ahead, take a minute and look around at all your stuff—they don't have any of that. The host pastor's "house" consisted of a 14x8 open room that served as a bedroom for him and his wife and their 2 boys as well as a 'kitchen.' Want some running water? No problem! Step outside the back door and you'll find a hose. And believe it or not, all 45 who attended were fed right there for 3 days.

5. The Cuban Christians have an unbelievable fervor for learning more about God's Word and an even greater fervor for sharing it with others.

6. And get this! They seem to be content and happy with their station in life and appear to be optimistic about the future. What was that Paul said to the people of Philippi? "I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances."

While there I challenged them with 4 points from our new seminar, *Standing Out in the Crowd*. When I finished the host pastor, Racial Sancho, wrapped things up with this challenge to those in attendance, "Go from here and put those 4 points into practice. And if you fail it is not because of God or Cuba ... it's your fault." At least, that's what Dino told me he said.

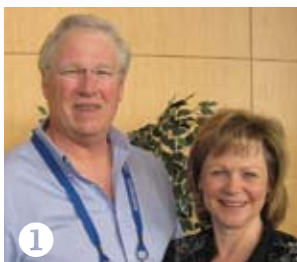
They have a successful team and a good chapel program for the players overseen by Tim Donelli. Walt is pictured speaking at one of those chapel meetings.
