Proposed 9-Day Itinerary for Germany 2010

Day 1: Monday, September 13 / FLY TO BERLIN

Day 2: Tuesday, September 14 / BERLIN

Our orientation tour of Berlin will include the Brandenburg Gate, the Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church, the Cathedral, and the Reichstag building.

Day 3: Wednesday, September 15 / WITTENBERG

We drive to Wittenberg, the birthplace of the Reformation at the very place Luther nailed his famous 95 Theses to the door of the Schlosskirche (Castle Church). We'll tour the Lutherhalle (Luther House) Museum and Stadtkirche St. Marien (St. Mary's church) where Luther preached.

Day 4: Thursday, September 16 / EISLEBEN, ERFURT

In the charming town of Eisleben, one of Luther's favorites, we'll tour the house where Luther was born and the house where he died. In Erfurt, we'll tour the Augustinian Monastery where he lived and worked as a monk and St. Mary's Cathedral where he was ordained.

Day 5: Friday, September 17 / EISENACH, ERFURT

This morning we will head for Eisenach and the Wartburg Castle where Luther took refuge in 1521 and translated Jerome's Vulgate into the German New Testament. Close by is the Bach House Museum, which is a must-see.

Day 6: Saturday, September 18 / AUSBURG, WIESKIRCHE and OBERAMMERGAU

On our way to Oberammergau, we'll visit Augsburg, another German Reformation city and the Wieskirche, a UNESCO World Heritage site with incredible Rococo art.

Day 7: Sunday, September 19 / OBERAMMERGAU

This afternoon we'll enjoy the world renowned Passion Play and highlight of our trip.

Day 8: Monday, September 20 / MUNICH

In Munich we'll have a drive-by orientation tour of the city's highlights with extra time for shopping or relaxing. We finish our fun tour with a farewell dinner of classic Bavarian cuisine and a live Bavarian folk show.
